

Sliva to retire from District 4

ADDISON — The Board of Education of Addison School District 4 has accepted the retirement request of Indian Trail Junior High School Principal Terry Sliva, which will become effective at the end of the 2009-2010 school year.

Mrs. Sliva joined the Addison School District in 1987 as a counselor for Indian Trail. After three years in that position, she accepted the position of assistant principal at Indian Trail, where she served for 13 years, prior to becoming the school's principal in 2003. Before coming to Addison, Sliva's employment experiences included positions in business as

well as in education. She began her career as a math teacher and junior high department chairperson. In subsequent years she worked as a service and accounting manager and as a securities and insurance broker before returning full-time to the field of education.

"Terry has been a strong leader in our district and she has had a positive influence on thousands of junior high students that she has worked with during the past 23 years," remarked District 4 Superintendent John Langton. "We congratulate her on her upcoming retirement, but we know that she will be difficult to replace."
