ADDISON — The Addison School District 4 Board of Education extends its gratitude to Kelly Ricamato for serving the Addison community for six years as a member of the Board. Ricamato has resigned her position for personal reasons and the Board will appoint a successor to fill this vacancy until the February 2013 election, at which time a successor shall be elected to serve the remainder of the unexpired term until April 2015.

The letter should outline why the candidate is interested

in serving on the Board and include an informational sheet indicating educational background, work history and other volunteer or related experiences that would be of interest to the School Board.

The qualifications for individuals who are interested in filling this vacancy are:

Must be 18 years of age;

Must be a resident of the State of Illinois and the school district for at least one year prior to the appointment;

Must be a registered voter and not a school trustee or school treasurer.

The Board will contact interested candidates prior to the next scheduled meeting of the Board of Education on August 24, 2011.
