### Old special ed records to be destroyed

ADDISON — Addison School District 4 will destroy special education records from the 2003-04 school year of students who graduated, transferred or were dismissed from special services.

Special education records may include reports of psychological and social work evaluations, multidisciplinary planning conferences, annual review, copies of individualized education programs and other relevant information.

If a parent or student wants those records, they should call the Pupil Personnel Office before Friday, October 9, at 630-458-2462. Copies of the rules and regulations that govern student records are available for the inspection at each school site and at the district office.
