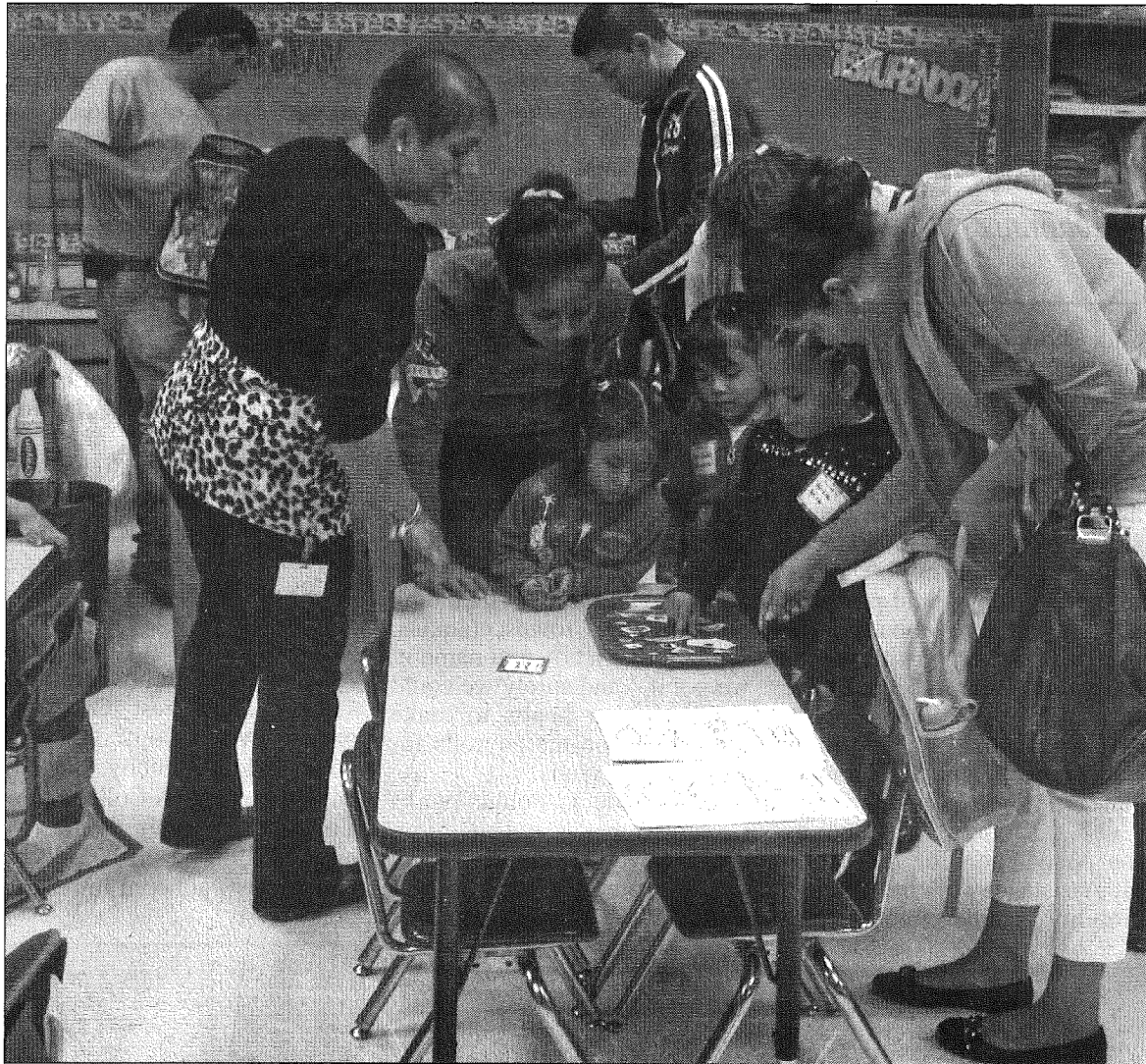


Dist 4 celebrates preschool, following hiatus

ADDISON — On Thursday, Oct 13, District 4 welcomed six sessions of preschoolers to the classrooms, after a year-long hiatus during which preschool was not offered, due to significant cuts in state funding. The new program houses a morn-

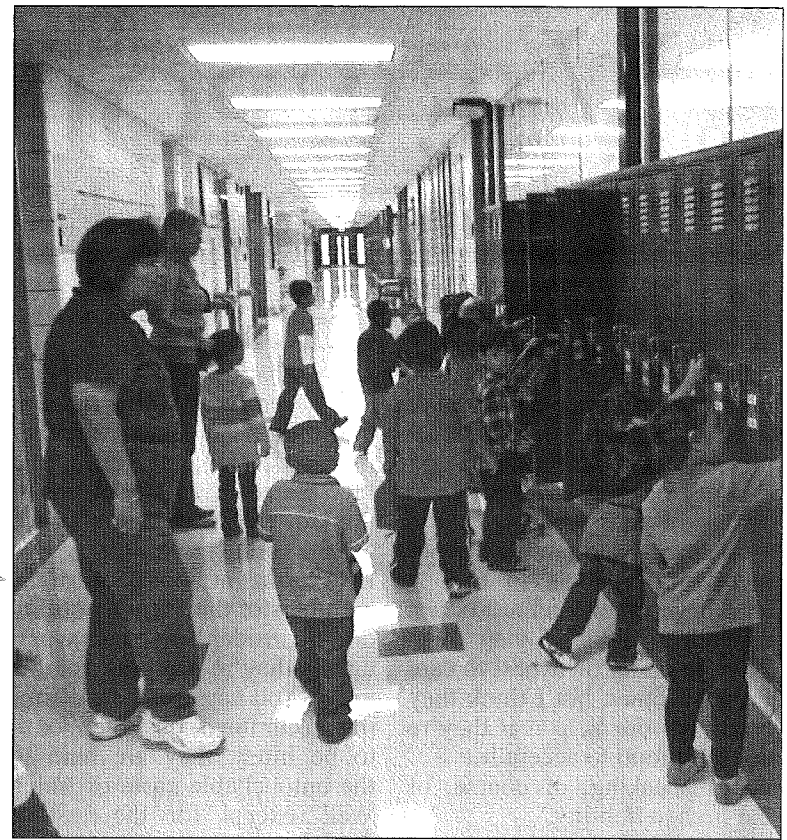
ing and an afternoon session of preschool in each of three school buildings—Ardmore, Army Trail and Stone School. Children must undergo screening in order to be deemed eligible for the program. Screenings are free, but parents need

to schedule an appointment in advance. Parents who wish to have their child evaluated during the screening dates should contact Laura Romero at Army Trail School, 630-458-2502. Currently, there is a waiting list for preschool classes.

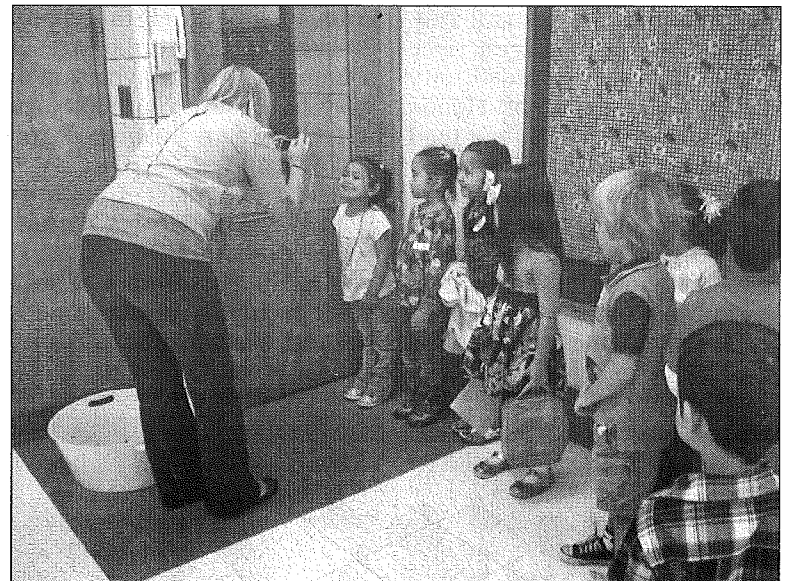


District 4 preschoolers work on a project on the first day of school. It's the first day since a year-long hiatus, due to cuts in state funding.
