

Mrs. Mullins Third Grade News for March

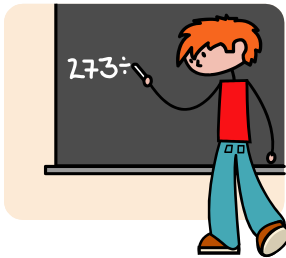

Click on the link to get there and have fun! It has lots of math manipulative activities including telling time, an important skill to know in second grade. The site also has Spanish option for those who prefer.

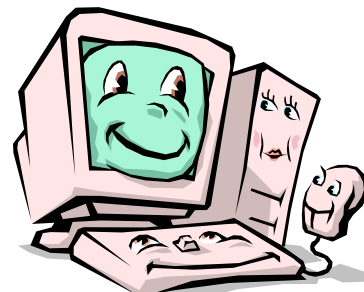
New this month is an additional math practice site suitable for all grade levels. <http://www.ixl.com>

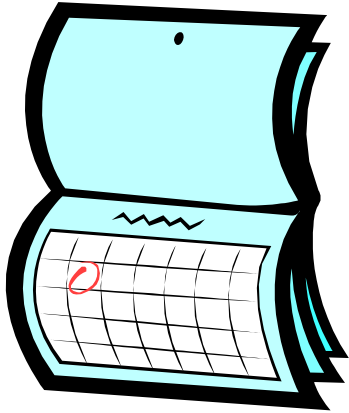
