The New Year brings many new things to the art room. The students will be coming back from break to some new and exciting lessons.

First grade explores the connections between Art and Music through the work of Kandinsky. The students will explore how different melodies and tempos can change emotions and painting style. Second grade will be traveling back in time to study a unit on prehistoric art forms!

Third grade and will study Van Gogh and the style in which he painted. They will create their very own masterpiece! Fourth grade will be diving into the world of abstract expressionism and study the work of Jasper Johns.
