### Dress for the weather

Please remember to check the daily weather forecast before sending your child to school. Make sure your child has a coat, hat, and gloves. District policy prevents the school from keeping a child indoors because they are not dressed appropriately for inclement weather. Remember that every Friday is *School Spirit Day*. Wear your Fullerton t-shirts, sweatshirts or school colors (blue & gold).



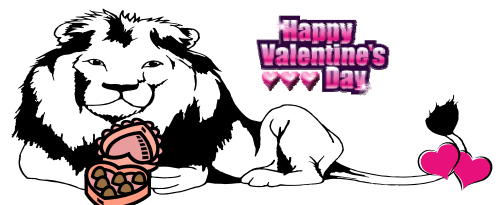

### PARENT NOTIFICATION OF STUDENT ABSENCES/TARDIES

Public schools are responsible for the safety and welfare of all children and this is a priority in each of our schools. When a child is absent or tardy (arriving late) to school, the school principal is responsible for making sure that the child is safe.

**It is the parent's responsibility to call the main school phone number 630-458-2950 or the direct 24 hr absence call-in number 630-458-2970 to report an absence or tardy by 10:00 am of the day of absence/tardy.**

When a parent does not report a absence or tardy, the school office personnel will attempt to call the parent/guardian to make sure that the child is safe. Please make sure that your home and emergency contact phone numbers are up to date.
