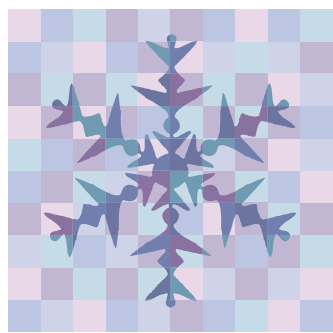
The February conferences are conducted on an as needed basis. Your child's teacher has already contacted you if a conference has been deemed necessary.
