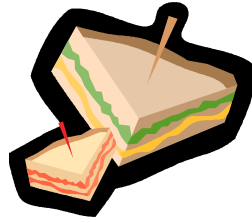

Central Public Health Center - Wheaton

Meningococcal (common cause of meningitis), Varicella (chickenpox), and Tdap (whooping cough) immunizations will be available to adolescents age 11 - 18 regardless of their VFC-eligibility status for \$15.00 each. This is a Medicaid billable service. A parent or legal guardian must accompany any child under the age of 18. Bring all records of previous immunizations given. **Space is limited. Biking

- *Always wear a snug fitting helmet
- *Obey the rules of the road
- *Look backwards before making a turn
- *Look for cars backing out

Fun in the Sun

- *The sun is strongest between 10am & 4pm
- *Apply sunscreen 30 minutes before going outside

Water

- *Use life vests for boating
- *Ponds, 5 gallon buckets, and wading pools are a drowning hazard for very young children
- *Make sure children are supervised around water
- *Long hair should be kept away from intake drains in hot tubs

Morning Drop Offs

Please remember that we have a drop and go policy at Stone School. This means that once your child has exited your vehicle you need to drive away.
