### Summer Safety Facts...

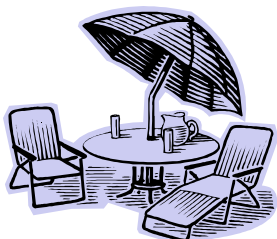
#### Trampolines

\*In 2001, 91,870 ER visits were due to trampoline injuries  
\*93% of victims were under age 15, 30% resulted in hospitalization & surgery  
\*Most injuries are due to children colliding with each other  
\*The American Academy of Pediatrics advises simply "never buy a trampoline"
