**COMMITTEES:**

**Cultural Arts:** Connie reported that the Jane Addams assembly will be February 16<sup>th</sup>. It will be in the morning, the afternoon kindergartners are invited to come. Connie wants to book another assembly for April, Mr. Langman said that Wednesday or Fridays are the best days. Barnes and Nobel night will be February 9<sup>th</sup>, at 6:30.
